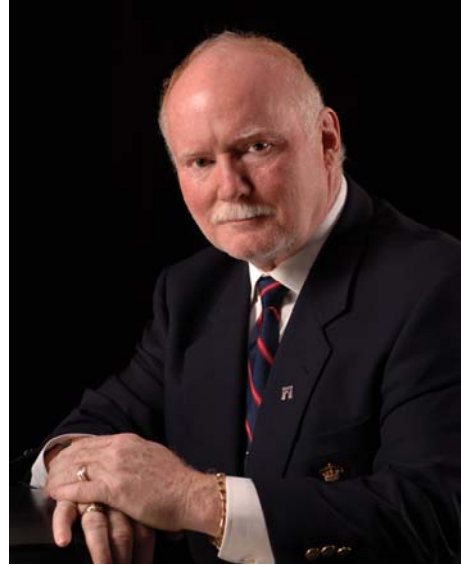


9660 Cameron H. Diggon, P.Eng.
